*Lick Creek/Fossil Pit hike: 1.5 mile hike (about 1.5 hours). Climb Vesper Mountain then drop into the valley below following Lick Creek, and stop by the Fossil Pit to find a souvenir. We will cover biomes (ecosystems), invasive species (cedar), human influence, erosion, classification of rocks, and classification of fossils.

*Warren Mountain Hike: 2 mile hike (about 2 hours). Take bus to the trail head at the back of camp. Follow Lick Creek through the valley. Enjoy creek crossings and 1 or 2 waterfalls (depending on water level). Climb the Warren Mountain rock face. The rock is a relatively steep and challenging climb, but we have 5 year olds participate in the hike routinely.

Make it an overnight trip!

If you choose to stay overnight, you can participate in our evening events and more activities the next day. Optional meals will be served at camp. You may choose to rent a whole cabin or pay per person. Cost includes activities.

Overnight Costs:

Cost per Person:

\$30 - includes cabin and activities

\$45 - includes cabin, activities, and 3 meals

*Parties of 2 or 3 may be asked to house with another group

Cost per Cabin: \$200 - cabins hold 10 people
